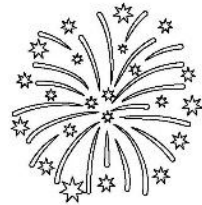
North Hopewell Twp. Police

Snow Information

Snow Emergencies: If 6 inches of snow has fallen within a 24-hour period, the snow emergency for **High Street & Main Street** will automatically be in effect.



Also, if they are **calling** for 6 or more inches of snow, a snow emergency may be declared and a press release will be done. After a Snow Emergency press release has been issued, you will have 1 hour to remove your vehicle from the street. If a vehicle is on the street during a snow emergency, the police will be called and you will receive a citation in accordance to the ordinance.

Shoveling: You cannot shovel, blow, plow or otherwise deposit snow onto the street after the street has been plowed. In accordance to Ordinance No. 2005-02 each resident of Felton Borough shall remove and clear away or cause to be removed or cleared away snow and/or ice the entire width and length of the sidewalk within 12 hours after the end of any snow, sleet or freezing rain. You will receive a letter if you are not in compliance. If there are repeated occurrences, there will be no notice given and enforcement in accordance with the ordinance will take place. You can be fined up to \$95 per occurrence.

Felton Borough Tax Rate

The Felton Borough Municipal tax millage rate for 2026 will change to 4 mills. This equates to \$400 on every \$100,000 of your properties assessed value. The previous rate of 3 mills held steady for 11 years.

Example: A \$200,000 assessed property will pay \$800 for the Municipal Tax you pay in the spring.

Garbage and Recycling

The quarterly fee for garbage collection will increase to **\$120.50** per quarter starting with the March 30, 2026 billing.

Do I Need a Permit for that?

Permits are required for the following items:

- Fence
- Most Decks
- Swimming Pool
- Sheds
- Pole Barns
- Expansion of Driveways
- New & expanded Parking Areas
- Solar Panel Installations
- Additions
- New Dwelling
- Whole House Generators

When in doubt, please call the office before starting any work.

 Beginning in January 2026 if you begin a project without a permit, you will pay **DOUBLE** the permit fees.

*****If your home is located in a flood zone, you need a permit for EVERY improvement you do to your home*****

Awarded Grants Update:

COVID-19 ARPA PA Grant Red Lion Ave Storm drainage: This project is complete.

Open Spaces Grant & Local Share Grant for a Borough Parking Lot at the Playground: This parking lot has been completed. The Borough will have cameras installed at the playground and baseball field in January 2026.

Seeking Grants:

Local Share Grant 2025 Main St Stormwater Replacement: Unfortunately, the Borough was not awarded this grant. We will keep an eye out for other grant opportunities.
