## Awarded Grants Update:

**Multi Modal Grant:** The remainder of this project, Moore Lane will be completed within the next couple of weeks.

**COVID-19 ARPA PA Grant Red Lion Ave Storm drainage:** JVI Group who is the Penn Dot contractor to resurface all of Felton Road was awarded the Borough's project at the April 7<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting. The Borough is awaiting the Penn Dot permit and then work will begin in the Borough.

**Church Lane:** This project has been completed.

**Open Spaces Grant & Local Share Grant for a Borough Parking Lot at the Playground:** The Borough was also awarded a Local Share Grant to complete this project. Our engineer is working through the final design and permit phase of the project and will put it out to bid soon.

## Seeking Grants:

**Local Share Grant 2025 Main St Stormwater Replacement:** The borough has applied for a grant to replace the storm drainage on Main Street in the borough. We anticipate finding out in the fall if we have been awarded the grant.

## York Water Sewer Rate Increase:

The York Water Company Filed a Rate Request Based on \$145 Million in Investment.

On May 30, 2025, The York Water Company filed a rate adjustment request with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission reflecting \$145 million in water and wastewater system investments to be made through February 2027 to continue providing safe and reliable service. The Company continues to make investments to replace aging infrastructure, comply with water quality and environmental regulations, and meet customers' water and wastewater service needs.

There are three ways to challenge a Company's request to change its rates:

1. You can file a formal complaint. If you want a hearing before a judge, you must file a formal complaint. By filing a formal complaint, you assure yourself the opportunity to take part in hearings about the rate increase request. All complaints should be filed with the PUC

before August 1, 2025. If no formal complaints are filed, the Commission may grant all, some, or none of the request without holding a hearing before a judge.

2. You can send us a letter telling why you object to the requested rate increase. Sometimes there is information in these letters that makes us aware of problems with the Company's service or management. This information can be helpful when we investigate the rate request.

Send your letter or request for a formal complaint form to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, Post Office Box 3265, Harrisburg, PA 17105-3265.

3. You can be a witness at a public input hearing. Public input hearings are held if the Commission opens an investigation of the Company's rate increase request and if there is a large number of customers interested in the case. At these hearings, you have the opportunity to present your views in person to the PUC judge hearing the case and the Company representatives. All testimony given "under oath" becomes part of the official rate case record. These hearings are held in the service area of the Company.
