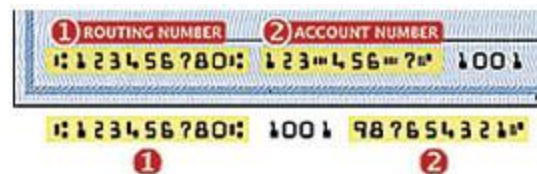
The payment processing company charges a service fee of **2.65 %** or **\$3.00** minimum to cardholders who use this service. Just stop by our office or give us a call at **717-246-6493** to use your MasterCard, Discover Card, American Express, or Visa.

Credit Card Payments Made Online

Now you can pay your **Garbage Collection Fee, Administration Fee for Building Permits, Zoning Permits, and Certification requests for Settlement** from the comfort of your home or office by using our online payment service. Credit cards accepted: MasterCard, Discover, American Express, or Visa. A per transaction service fee of **2.65 %** or **\$3.00** minimum will be charged by the payment processing company for this service.

Electronic Check Payments

Felton Borough now accepts electronic check payments using our online payment service. Payments will be charged to your checking or savings account at your bank. You will need your 9-digit routing number, as well as your account number from your personal checks (see example below). A per transaction service fee of \$1.50 will be charged by the payment processing company for this service.

COVID-19 ARPA PA Small Water & Sewer Grant

The borough applied for a grant to replace the storm sewers on Red Lion Avenue. This project will replace the storm sewers on the west side of Red Lion Avenue and also install new storm sewers on the east side to capture the storm waters that are currently directed behind the homes on that side. The borough expects to find out in late summer whether we have been awarded the grant.

CDBG Grant

This grant is to replace the handicap ramps on Main Street and install a new handicap ramp at the corner of High Street and Main Street.

The borough has received the Penn Dot permits and the project will be put out to bid soon. Construction is slated to take place this summer.

Multi Modal Grant

The borough was awarded a Multimodal grant through Penn Dot to do improvements on Water Street and Moore Lane. Due to increased costs in materials, the borough had to reduce the scope of work to only include Water Street to Main Street and the portion of Moore Lane from Water Street to Church Avenue. We should have the agreement with Penn Dot finalized in the next few weeks so the project can be put out to bid shortly thereafter. Construction is expected to take place late summer into the early fall.

BE AWARE OF DIRTY DIRT!!!

DEP wants to help residents and contractors in Pennsylvania ensure they do not accept or use fill materials that may cause contamination. Fill materials are used to bring sites to desirable grades to enhance the usefulness of the properties.

Homeowners and contractors need to be aware that there are some "fill" materials out there that can cause potential environmental and/or health concerns, as well as open up property owners to potential liabilities. Here are a few tips to ensure you are using acceptable fill materials on your property

Do your homework...Take a look...or smell...Get some advice...

Before you buy or accept "FREE" dirt, make sure it is clean. Know the source of the fill, especially if it is offered to you for FREE. Know the supplier and hauler. Check for references. Ask for documentation from the provider regarding the source:

- A bill of lading if you purchased it.
- An official DEP FP-001 form that identifies where the fill came from and any testing that was done.

Do not accept any free material without documentation.

If the fill has a petroleum/oil-like or garbage odor...**BEWARE!** If the fill has materials such as plastic, ash, demolition debris such as wallboard, shingles, nails, wood or paint chips...**BEWARE!**

If the fill appears to be "discolored" or stained...**BEWARE!** If you don't know the source of the fill...**BEWARE!**

The DEP wants residents and contractors in Pennsylvania to make sure they do not accept or use fill materials that may contain or cause contamination. Check with your regional office if you have questions, consult with your local Bureau of Waste Management or DEP office. If you don't know the source of the fill...**BEWARE!**
