Grants Update:

CDBG Grant

This project went out for bid in February. The costs came in higher than expected so the borough had to table the project. Additional money is being requested to complete the project. Once confirmed the borough will be able to award the project and move onto construction.

Multi Modal Grant

The project will be going out to for bid soon. This project will be reclamation and paving of Water Street from the Beaver Street Bridge to Main Street and Moore Lane from Water Street to Church Avenue.

COVID-19 ARPA PA Grant

This project will be going out for bid in the very near future.

This project will replace and install new storm water controls along Red Lion Avenue in the borough.

Red Lion Avenue Bridge Replacement

Penn Dot is planning to start the bridge replacement project the beginning of June. The road will be closed and a detour will be in place.



Ordinance Spotlight:

Grass & Weed Ordinance ~

Ordinance 2008-01 regulates the growth of weeds, grass, and similar vegetation, not grown for agricultural purposes, establishes procedures for violations and provides penalties for the violation thereof. Ordinance states that you will only be notified one time per season for any violations of this ordinance. If you



receive one notice and you violate the ordinance a 2nd time, a citation will be filed against the property owner without any further notices. As a reminder, any grass, weeds, or similar vegetation exceeding six (6) inches in height is a violation of this ordinance.

Trees, Shrubs, Hedges

Ordinance ~ Ordinance 2006-03 regulates the planting, removal and maintaining of trees, shrubs, hedges, and other vegetation and obstructions along public ways; requiring clearance of streets and sidewalks. Due to safety concerns, it is the responsibility of every homeowner to keep all trees on or in front of their property, with branches extending over the cart way of any public road, street, or alley, trimmed or cut and kept trimmed or

cut, such branches and limbs thereof so extending so as to maintain a clearance of 14 feet above the roadway of any street or alley and 8 feet above the sidewalk. Also, to keep all trees, shrubs, hedges, and other vegetation within the public right away, trimmed or cut so as not to obstruct the vision of motorist or interfere in any manner with the public or governmental use of any public street or right away.

SCAM ALERT from SSA

Watch out! Scammers target everyone.

Recognize scammers. They may:

- ✓ **PRETEND** to be from an agency or organization you know.
- ✓ Say there's a **PROBLEM** or promise a prize.
- ✓ **PRESSURE** you to act immediately.
- ✓ Tell you to **PAY** in a specific way.

Do not give scammers money or personal information – Ignore them!

How to avoid a scam:

- Remain calm. Talk to someone you trust.
- Hang up or ignore the message. **DO NOT** click on links or attachments.
- Protect your money. Criminals will insist that you pay in a hard-to-trace manner, such as with a gift card, prepaid debit card, cryptocurrency, wire transfer, money transfer, or by mailing cash.
- Protect your personal information. Be skeptical of a contact you did not initiate.
- Spread the word. Share your knowledge of Social Security-related scams. Post on social media using the hashtag #SlamtheScam to share your experience and warn others. Visit ssa.gov/scam for more information. Please also share with your friends and family.
