## Zoning Hearing Board Member

Felton Borough is looking for a resident to serve on the Zoning Hearing Board. The ZHB only meets as needed. Below is a brief description of the duties. If interested, please contact the office.

**What Is a Zoning Hearing Board?** The Zoning Hearing Board (ZHB) is a quasi-judicial body that hears and renders decisions regarding specific types of land

use actions. The ZHB functions like a court, although formal court procedures are not necessarily required. The Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code (MPC) provides a specific set of rules that must be followed for applications submitted to the ZHB.

**Reasons for Hearing ZHBs** - review applications for specific reasons as outlined in the MPC, including:

- Applications for a variance or a use by special exception
  - Challenges to the validity of a land use ordinance, including those raising procedural questions or alleging defects in the enactment process
  - Appeals to a determination from a zoning officer, municipal engineer, or agency on preliminary opinions, floodplain determinations, transfers of development rights, or administration of sedimentation and erosion control or stormwater management

## Notary Service Available

Borough Secretary, Joy Flinchbaugh, is a Notary Public for the Commonwealth of PA and will provide confidential notarial services for the residents of Felton Borough for the fees allowed by law.

The services she can provide include:

1. Acknowledgements ~ witnessing or attesting signatures

2. Oaths or Affirmations ~ Verifications on an Oath or Affirmation
3. Copy of Certifications ~ Protests of Negotiable Instruments.

As required by the Commonwealth of PA, Joy has obtained a bond amount of \$10,000 and completed the mandatory basic notary course of study. Joy's term of office is May 6, 2022 to May 6, 2026.

Please note the signer of any document must appear in person before Joy. If the signer is not personally known to Joy, he or she must present a current, government-issued ID. A driver's license or non-driver photo ID meets these requirements. Full cooperation with this requirement is sincerely appreciated and will be strictly enforced.

## York County Solid Waste Authority Will Hold a Free Household Hazardous Waste Collection Event

York County Solid Waste Authority (YCSWA) will hold a FREE Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Collection Event on **Saturday, October 11 from 9 a.m.- 1 p.m.** The event will be held at the paved lot behind the YCSWA Recycling Drop-Off Center located on Blackthorne Court, York.

Registration is required. Online registration is available for residents at <https://www.eventbrite.com/e/york-county-solid-waste-authoritys-household-hazardous-waste-event-tickets-1537812642009?aff=oddttdcreator>. Space is limited.

While attending the event, all participants must remain in their vehicles and contain all collection materials in the trunk or bed of vehicle (not the back seat). Materials will be removed from vehicle trunk/bed by event staff. Smoking is not permitted at any time during the event.

Household hazardous waste includes products from the home that are corrosive (drain cleaners or bleach), flammable (gasoline), reactive (pool chemicals) or toxic (pesticides). The HHW Collection Event benefits York County by identifying hazardous waste found in the home and providing an opportunity to manage these materials in a safe and efficient manner.

All York County residents are eligible to take advantage of this event. There is no fee to participate. Business and government entities are not eligible to participate. The program is made possible by funding generated from tipping fees collected at the York County Resource Recovery Center and a grant from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection. After collection, a licensed hazardous waste commercial hauler will transport and manage the household hazardous waste recycling as much of the materials as possible.
