ORDINANCE NO. 2021-01

**AN ORDINANCE OF FELTON BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE BOROUGH TAX
COLLECTOR TO CHARGE A FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF
REAL ESTATE TAX CERTIFICATIONS, DUPLICATE TAX BILLS,
DUPLICATE TAX RECEIPTS, AND RETURN CHECKS**

IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of Felton Borough, York County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Tax Collector for Felton Borough is hereby authorized to charge the following fees in connection with the performance of his/her duties:

| 1. | Issuance of Tax Certifications upon request by attorneys, realtors, title abstract companies, financial institutions or other parties with respect to the current or prior year real estate taxes upon a particular parcel of real estate | \$ 20 |
| 2. | Issuance of duplicate tax bills upon request of a property owner or other person or institution or in connection with the payment of real estate taxes where no bill is enclosed with the check and a duplicate bill must be provided by the tax collector | \$ 5 |
| 3. | Providing duplicate tax bills upon request of a property owner or other person or institution | \$ 5 |
| 4. | Return check fee | \$ 25 |

The above fees may be changed in the future, from time to time, by the Felton Borough Council by Resolution.


SECTION 2. The Tax Collector is authorized to retain the fees set forth in SECTION 1 above as reimbursement for his or her expenses in connection with the issuance of said certifications or duplicate bills or receipts.


SECTION 3. All provisions of any previous Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.


